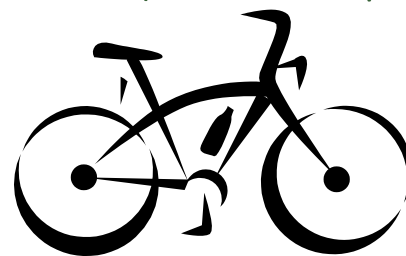
SAT 08 JUNE
